Must Dos

Reading

Choose one square from the “Reading Bingo Board” daily. Please record on the daily reading log. If you need additional stories to use for this, you can access the following...

Writing

Choose one square from the “Writing Bingo Board” daily. Most of these tasks will require you to use paper from home. Please take a pic, and submit to your child’s teacher.

Spelling & Vocabulary

Please practice sight word ring daily. As students master the words on the ring, move on to the sight word page in your child’s leadership notebook. It is equally important to be able to write these words. So, as your child masters reading them, return to them and practice spelling/writing those words.

Math

Study addition/subtraction facts for 15 minutes each day. K’s facts 1-5, 6-10

1st Grade facts 10-20. Students can:

- Practice facts with a partner
- Create flash cards
- Write them
- Work on ZEARN
- One time a week write numbers to 120 and Kindergarten to 100
- Choose one activity from the Math BINGO Board

The following are “can dos” that can be done in addition to the “must dos”:

- Monday (science)- Complete an activity from the “Science Bingo Board” or watch a Kindergarten/First Grade Mystery Science lesson: <https://mysteryscience.com/lessons/seasonal/current-events>
- Tuesday (math)-Write one math addition story and a math subtraction problem
- Wednesday (social studies)-Complete an activity from the “Social Studies Bingo Board” or watch a social studies Brain Pop Jr. video and complete quiz: <https://www.brainpop.com/> (login: northhancock password: kids)
- Thursday (reading)-Create a thinking map (bubble map, double bubble map, circle map, tree map, flow map) describing one book that you have read this week.
- Fun Friday - Choose an art, music or physical education activity.
