Click on the Home Tab and then the New SFSP Meal Delivery Program link to register your students. Student accounts will be charged if they receive extras while utilizing Support Services or are in the school building. If you have not completed your Free/Reduced Meal Application, go to your Parent Portal account and click on More, the "click here to start your application" link.
